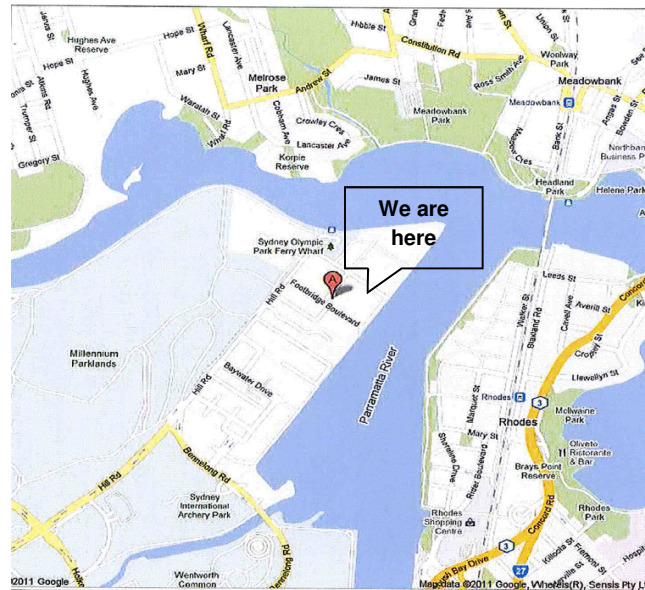

DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE



Defensive Driving Course

This course is designed to modify an operator's driving techniques through a combination of theoretical and practical sessions. To achieve this, we recommend a theory session (can be group) of 2 - 4 hours, and an individual two hour practical training and assessment session.

At the end of the course, the operator will be able to:

-  Implement vehicle sympathy
-  Identify safe driving strategies
-  Increase defensive driving techniques
-  Monitor own attitudes to reduce driver accidents

COURSE TOPICS

Topics covered in the theory component of the course can include:

Road Laws

Participants will discuss road laws and the most common abuses of road laws.

Vehicle Sympathy

When operators respect their vehicle and follow the proper pre and post departure checks, plus service routines, the vehicle will be safe, reliable and cost efficient.

Road Craft versus Car Craft

Operators will review their driving within the road system.

Road Craft is a driver's competence in participation and interaction with other road users.

Car Craft is defined as a person who drives in a reckless manner taking little consideration for other road users.

Safe Driving Strategies

Visual search techniques provide drivers with ways to actively observe the traffic scene to assist with safe driving decisions.

Attitude and Driving Behaviour

The driver of a vehicle must display the right attitude in all situations. If the wrong attitude is expressed, a driver can abuse other road users, and the vehicle for which he/she is responsible.

Reducing Vehicle Accidents

Participants learn how to identify the potential causes of accidents and how to drive defensively, therefore reducing the number of vehicle accidents.

Fatigue Management

Driving hours and monitoring a driver's fatigue is discussed. Participants will review their own lifestyle and establish strategies to manage their fatigue.

Specific requirements such as OH&S, accident statistics, and policies and procedures relating to vehicle management are reviewed.
