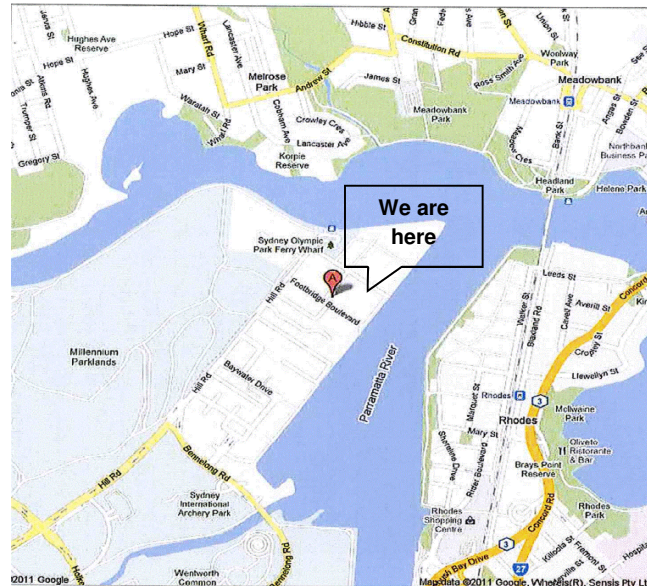

Competency Based Assessment

Licensing System

If you live in Sydney, the Central Coast or Newcastle, Competency Based Assessment is the primary method to upgrade to a Heavy Vehicle licence. You will be required to undergo a Knowledge Test at the RTA and be issued with a log book. CBA provides assessment under a wide range of driving conditions by an RTA accredited assessor. Some or all of the following skills will be assessed, dependent on HV licence being obtained:

-  Basic Road Skills
-  Applying Road Rules
-  Safe Driving
-  Driving in Traffic
-  Open Road
-  Secure the Load
-  Manoeuvres
-  Bus Stop
-  Couple & Uncouple

The Transport Industry favours the CBA system because the thorough training and assessment prepares drivers to be more professional, and to have the correct skills to operate heavy vehicles on today's roads.

When you have demonstrated that you can perform the required competencies, results are progressively recorded in the RTA log book and assessments are only repeated if are deemed Not Competent. When the Final Competency Assessment is successful completed and reported to the RTA by the assessor, you are required to go to any RTA motor registry to be issued with an upgraded licence.

Heavy Vehicle Licence Upgrades

Royce Driver Training Group Pty Ltd uses the RTA Competency Based Assessment (CBA) licensing system for all Heavy Vehicle Licence Upgrades which includes Light Rigid, Medium Rigid, Heavy Rigid and Heavy Combination.

You will also incur RTA fees of approximately \$120 for the knowledge test, log books and photo licence.







It is a requirement of the RTA that the knowledge test be passed before a heavy vehicle log book can be issued. Lessons can commence when
