INFORMATION ABOUT MC UPGRADES CONDUCTED AT ROYCE TRAINING GROUP

Participants wishing to complete an MC upgrade at Royce Training Group will be required to attend a group course with three clients over two days. We are unable to conduct the course for individuals.

Tenure Requirements

To meet the tenure requirements for an MC licence you must have held a Heavy Rigid (HR) or Heavy Combination (HC) licence for a period of, or for periods totalling at least 1 year. Applicants upgrading from a HR licence are required to complete an HC licence prior to attending a MCDT&A course.

RTA Requirements

Prior to attending a Multi-Combination Driver Training and Assessment Course, applicants must attend a motor registry and:

- Either provide a current photo-licence or Proof of Identity which meet RTA requirements
- Complete a Licence Application Form for the National Heavy Vehicle Driver Licensing Scheme
- Provide a completed medical report (supplied by the RTA)
- Pass a Multi-Combination knowledge test (visit the web on www.rta.new.gov.au for a practice test or to view the Heavy Vehicle Drivers' and Road Users' Handbooks. These may be purchased through the RTA for a cost of \$11 each. The cost of the knowledge test \$39).
- Pass an eyesight test
- Confirm licence tenure

On completion of the above requirements, the licence application form should be endorsed "**Approved to attend Multi-Combination Driver Training and Assessment Course**" and stamped by the RTA. The endorsed licence application form must be presented to us to verify compliance with the pre-requisite entry criteria.

Previous Experience

There are no prerequisites with regard to driving experience, however the standards expected to obtain your MC qualification are quite rigid. Attending this course does not guarantee a licence. Full compliance to the RTA standards must be achieved.

The course is held at our depot, located in Homebush Bay and is conducted by Mr. Steve Shiels.

Fees for MC upgrades – 3 participants – conducted at Homebush Bay

The 2-day (three clients) MC licence course	\$1,350.00 (per person)
Additional training costs if not competent	\$ 190.00 per hour

Course Structure

The course is conducted with three operators

Day One	Morning session	0830 – 1230	Theory session for three operators
	Afternoon session	1300 – 1700	Practical session with Operator 1
Day Two	Morning session	0800 – 1200	Practical session with Operator 2
	Afternoon session	1230 – 1630	Practical sessions with Operator 3

A deposit of 50% of the full course cost will be required at the time of booking, and can be made (or secured) by Credit Card (3% surcharge applies) or by Direct Deposit to our bank account.

Cancellation Policy
